GRAND PARADE Notes: a. In all classes, manners to be considered. b. All ponies to be ridden by girl or boy
under 17 years at the date of The Show, except for Novice Ponies which may be ridden by a rider of any age in
Novice classes ONLY c. Consideration cannot be given to riders of horses or ponies where classes of different
groups coincide. d. Entires to be allowed on grounds but if misbehaving will be ordered from grounds by Committee
member responsible. Stallions, with the exception of miniatures, when led should be controlled by a colt bit with a
single lead. Stallions are not to be tied up unattended unless in an appropriate confinement (please note that the
yards at Amberley A. & P Show are not designed for stallions.). At the time of entry, all stallion owners must be in
possession of a stallions identification badge, which must be displayed at all times while at the show. Official
badges are available from the NZEF. In a warm up area a stallion must be accompanied by at least one attendant,
in addition to the rider, and the rider must wear an identification bib. e. Novices are graded on the wins of the
horse or pony not the wins of a combination. Once a horse or pony has accumulated 5 wins in any section it is no
longer a novice in any other section. Novices to be shown in Simple Snaffle Bits in Novice class. f. Unity
Competition - Consideration to be given to manners of pony, care and fitting of tack, turnout of pony and rider.
Simple snaffle bits only to be used. g. In all classes where height or grading of the horse or rider or the age of the
rider is specified APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATES MUST BE CARRIED. Performance Certificates are available
