Please Note: Back Numbers (\$2 each) are to be paid for with Entry Fees, one Back Number is required for each Horse and Rider Combination; this will be refunded on return of Back Numbers on Show Day. If you have your own numbers please indicate on the Entry Form. The deposit is not then required. Please note that parking is at a premium, so if you are asked to move please do so otherwise you may be disqualified from competition. Trailers will be available for animal waste only - rubbish bins will be there for other waste. A limited number of yards are available at \$25.00 per yard. HORSE EXHIBITORS ARE REMINDED THAT ALL PRIZE WINNERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE PRESENT FOR THE GRAND PARADE Notes: a. All Conformation Classes will be judged Conformation 60% and Manners 40%. b. All ponies to be ridden by girl or boy under 17 years at the date of The Show, except for Novice Ponies which may be ridden by a rider of any age in Novice classes ONLY c. Consideration cannot be given to riders of horses or ponies where classes of different groups coincide. d. Entries displaying disruptive behaviour on the grounds may be asked, by a Committee member, to leave the grounds. Stallions, with the exception of miniatures, when led should be controlled by a colt bit with a single lead. Stallions are not to be tied up unattended unless in an appropriate confinement (please note that the yards at Amberley A. & P Show are not designed for stallions.). At the time of entry, all stallion owners must be in possession of a stallions identification badge, which must be displayed at all times while at the show. Official badges are available from the NZEF. In a warm up area a stallion must be accompanied by at least one attendant, in addition to the rider, and the rider must wear an identification bib. e. A NOVICE is a horse or pony which has not won 6 wins in Conformation Classes at any A. & P. Show. (Ladies' and Gentlemen's hack classes count as an Open Conformation class and must be counted) A novice in Paced and Mannered classes is a horse or pony which has not won 6 firsts in Paced and Mannered classes at any A. & P. Show Novices to be shown in Simple Snaffle Bits in Novice class. f. Unity Competition - Consideration to be given to manners of pony, care and fitting of tack, turnout of pony and rider. Simple snaffle bits only to be used. g. In all classes where height or grading of the horse or rider or the age of the rider is specified APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATES MUST BE CARRIED failure to carry certificates will result in elimination. Performance Certificates are available from the Royal Agricultural Society. The Royal Agricultural Society collates all A. & P. Show results to enable Secretaries to keep a record of all novice wins. h. Forbidden Substance Testing. The use of stimulants, tranquilisers, or any substance which affects the performance of horse or ponies is forbidden. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show. Testing all animals will be at the owners risk and will be carried out under FSJC procedures(Ref.10 of the RAS By Laws and Regulations section 55 A) Your signature on the entry form and /or participation in competition denotes acceptance of these conditions (REF Rule 889 of RAS equestrian Competitors and Judges Rule Book) i.
