Competitors please note: The Health & Safety Act requires that hard hats are worn during competitions. All rings are split and offer Novice and Open Classes - only novice horses may enter in novice classes - all may enter in open classes. Paced and mannered class winners from all rings are eligible for the paced and mannered championship but NOT for ring championship. In all rings first prize winners only to parade for champions. Once the champion has been selected the second placed animal to the champion MUST be allowed to parade for the judging of reserve champion. One championship or two reserve championships

in the open rings qualify animals for the New Zealand Horse of the Year Show. Novice Classification A Novice is a horse or pony which has not won 6 firsts in conformation classes at any A & P Show at the time of the show (Ladies and Gentlemen's Hack class wins count as an Open Conformation win and must be recorded). If a Novice entry has gained 6 wins by the day of the show, the competitor must advise the secretary's office and may change to an Open class within the sub-section, or if no class remains to enter a refund will be actioned after the show. A Novice Paced and Mannered horse/pony is one which has not won 6 firsts in Paced and Mannered classes. Please note that a record of wins will be asked for. Horse/Pony height and performance cards must be carried. Failure to do so will result in elimination. Once a horse/pony has achieved 6 wins in either the conformation classes or Paced and Mannered classes, this horse/pony is not eligible to return to Novice status should it change sections at the beginning of a new show season - excludes Lead Rein and First Ridden. For Group Classes Only, 'ENTRY' in lieu of name of animal will be accepted, provided that every animal involved is entered in its basic classes. 7. All cattle Entries in-milk classes must be accompanied by production figures for the last period, on entry form. 8. All cattle (except unregistered calves) must be named on entry form, except those in groups. 9. If any injection or dosing is given to any animal the exhibitor must report this to a Chief Steward of the section. 10. Any alteration of conformation of cattle as per RAS rules will be considered malpractice and disqualified from the show.
