Once a horse or pony has had 6 wins it is not eligible for the Novice Classes. 3. Novice in Paced & Mannered Classes is a horse or pony which has yet to win 6 firsts. 4. Novices may enter Open Classes. 5. Any Lady's Hack Class win counts as an Open Conformation Class. 6. Novice Champions are not eligible for Open Championships unless they have won their Open Class, nor are they eligible for Supreme Award. Champion Award does not count as a win. 7. Novice horses or ponies must be shown in SNAFFLE BITS only in Novice Classes. 8. If a novice entry has gained more than 6 wins by the day of the Show, the competitor must advise the Secretary's office and may change to an Open Class, or, if no class remains to enter, a refund will be actioned at such time as the Show Committee decides.
