Novice Section - conditions 1. A Novice is a Horse or Pony which has not won more than 5 firsts in conformation classes at any A & P Show, at the time of the show. 2. Once a horse or pony has had 5 wins it is not eligible for the novice classes. 3 Novice in Paced and Mannered classes is a horse or pony which has not won more than 5 firsts 4. Novices may enter Open classes. 5. Hacks: Any Lady's Hack class wins count as an Open Conformation Class. 6. Novice champions are not eligible for Open championships unless they have won their Open class, nor are they eligible for Supreme Award. Championship award does not count as a win. 7. Novice horses or ponies must be show in SNAFFLE BITS only, in novice classes (excepting Harness classes). 8.
