Section 2, Floral Art: All plant material to be of good quality and conditioned to last over the 2 days of the Show. Section 3, Field & Garden Produce: All entries must be clean, Carrot & Beetroot tops trimmed to approx. 5cms. Rhubarb pulled from plant not cut, stalk tidied and leaves cut to approx. 3cms above stalk. Section 4a, Home Industries: Entries to be exhibitors own work, no packet mixes or bought pastries. More than 1 entry in the same class must be from different batches. Section 4a: Preserves, jams and pickles in clean and neatly labelled jars with screw bands removed. (Collections to be in matching jars.) Sections 5 & 6 all entries to be clean. Not starched but carefully pressed where applicable. Section 7.
