CAREFULLY Approved Safety Helmets to be worn at all times while mounted and acceptable in all classes.

NZPCA Untagged helmets to be presented at secretary's office before the jumping in afternoon. PLEASE NOTE:  
THE CANTERBURY AREA PONY CLUB YELLOW REPORT SHEET WILL BE IN USE AT THIS EVENT FOR ANY  
ABUSE OF THE HORSE, RIDER OR OFFICIAL. No horse, pony or rider is eligible for both hack and pony rings, or  
showing and Pony Club rings. The committee reserves the right to alter, delete or combine any class or classes as  
it sees fit. A Novice Horse, Pony, Coloured or Standardbred is one that does not have more than the number of  
firsts (against all breeds) specified in this schedule. All Firsts, won before closing date of entries, at A & P Shows,  
Pony Club Shows, Breeders or Riding Club shows to be counted. Snaffle bits to be worn in all classes for Novices  
with not more than the specified number of firsts, as stated in this schedule. Lead Rein and First Ridden ponies  
MUST be shown in a snaffle bridle.. HEIGHT CERTIFICATES COULD BE CHECKED in all open showing rings.  
There are measuring days available to all competitors at A & P show grounds before this show. Height  
restrictions do not apply to rider classes, please enter the correct class for your age. Age of rider as at the date of  
the show. Only mares and geldings may compete, colts or stallions not allowed. Entry fees \$4.00 per class, plus  
\$10.00 levy per horse/pony. Fees include \$4.00 Area levy, \$2.00 ChCh P.C. Levy, ground fee, and First Aid. There  
will be programmes available on the day at a cost of \$2.00each. Please indicate on entry if required or they will be  
available to download from the internet. FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES. REFUNDS - There will be no  
refund of entry fees except 75% may be refunded on presentation of a vet's or doctor's certificate within seven (7)  
days from date of show, postal date must reflect this. Ellesmere Pony Club follows the NZPC doping policy for

Ellesmere Pony Club ensure all cups and trophies are in perfect condition when presented to winners, all winners are therefore responsible for any repairs to cups/trophies that are needed while in their care. ### **RING SIX - First Ridden and Lead Rein Section**

Conditions For Lead Rein, First Ridden sections - Lead Rein Ponies - Open to ponies not over 148cm. Pony must be over 5 years old. - Open to riders 4 years old and not over 10 years. - Pony to be ridden in a snaffle bridle, no Pelham's or Kimblewicks allowed - Riders entered in this ring are NOT eligible for any classes in the first ridden section. - Conformation of mount will not necessarily be considered in the Lead Rein section. - WHIPS: If you must carry one. Must be either a short cane or a 75cm whip (including flapper) NO Long or dressage whips allowed. Lead rein must be attached to a halter, you will be asked to leave the ring and put on. First Ridden Ponies - Open to Riders 12 years & under ponies not over 148cm. Pony must be over 5 years old. - One adult per child to be available at the ringside at all times. - Pony most suitable for riders competing in their first year off the lead. (ie one Ellesmere P.C show to the next) - Pony to be ridden in a snaffle bridle, no Pelham's or Kimblewicks allowed. NO dressage whips allowed. - Conformation of mount will not necessarily be considered. - Classes will not be asked to canter as a group, but riders may be asked to canter individually. - Riders to leave the ring at a walk please. Conditions for both Lead Rein & First Ridden Sections - Entries in these two sections may not enter any other section, except for a Pony Club unity Class. - Entries in the Lead Rein and First Ridden section ARE NOT eligible for any jumping classes. - Pony Club uniform or similar to be worn NO JACKETS - NO EXCEPTIONS - NZPCA approved safety helmets to be worn at all times while mounted - Plaiting is optional.
