All leaders of cattle must wear a white coat or a recognised breed uniform or will not be permitted to enter the judging ring. 2. All cattle must be entered in the name of the bona-fide owner. 3. Entry in the show entitles the Society to publish an exhibitor's name in result reports and distribute with exhibitor lists. 4. Age of dairy cattle shall be computed as at 1st June unless otherwise stated. 5. No animal will be allowed to compete in more than one class, except in Special Classes, and in Special Classes no animal may compete without being entered in ordinary class for which it is eligible. 6. For Group Classes Only, 'ENTRY' in lieu of name of animal will be accepted, provided that every animal involved is entered in its basic classes. 7. All cattle Entries in-milk classes must be accompanied by production figures for the last period, on entry form. 8. All cattle (except unregistered calves) must be named on entry form, except those in groups. 9. If any injection or dosing is given to any animal the exhibitor must report this to a Chief Steward of the section. 10. Any alteration of conformation of cattle as per RAS rules will be considered malpractice and disqualified from the show. **PROTEST:** Any protest must be made in writing, signed by the person making the complaint and delivered to the Secretary accompanied by \$200 cash which will be refunded should the protest be upheld. **ALL EXHIBITORS** are required to maintain good control over the area in which their cattle are stalled and to keep equipment in tidy order at all times so as not to interfere with access through the passageways. **TUBERCULOSIS TESTING** 1. (a) For animals from Declared TB Movement Controlled Areas: All show animals over the age of 90 days are to be tested, and have a clear test within 60 days prior to being moved to the show. (b) For animals from C10 status herds in Surveillance Areas (e.g. . Northland) - No test is required but a clearly dated test allocation form or other documentation from the Animal Health Board must be submitted that shows the herd is not overdue for a whole herd test. (c) For animals from all other herds and areas - If the herd has a C3 status or better, no test is required PROVIDED the last whole herd test was within 12 months prior to the show. (i) If the last whole herd test was not within 12 months of the show, then show cattle over one year old MUST have a clear test within the current show season. (ii) If the herd has a status of C1 or C2, then show cattle over one year old MUST have a clear test within the current show season. 2. This certificate showing individual animal identification numbers must accompany completed entry forms when returned to the Secretary. 3. All exhibitors must sign the declaration on the official entry form. 4. Animals being moved to a show MUST HAVE the Official Eartag Identification i.e. Primary and secondary tags. Animal Status Declaration Card (Must accompany cattle in transit and will be collected on arrival at the show) All cattle entered for showing which are 1 month of age and over must be accompanied in transit by the usual signed and dated Animal Status Declaration Card, showing either TB Free or C2 Herd Status or better, in accordance with present law. **MALPRACTICE RULES DRUGS and FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCES** means any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage, conformation or conduct of an animal by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.
