## RULES AND REGULATIONS

MARLBOROUGH A & P ASSOCIATION RULES AND REGULATIONS NOTE: These are to be read in conjunction with other rules and conditions outlined in their respective Sections and the Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ and their Affiliated Associations. 1. No Entries will be considered unless Entry Form (including online entry) has been completed. 2. All entries must be made in the name of the bona fide owner of the exhibitor. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry. No entry will be valid unless these conditions are complied with. ENTRY FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE. 3a. Except in the Home Produce and Needlework Sections, and in those classes or competition which are sponsored by independent advertisers, and in those classes which are subject to age limits, prize money in any class shall not exceed the entry fee received by the Association. Where provision applies the available entry fee shall be paid out as two thirds first, one third second. Does not apply in any sponsored events. 3b. Where the provision of paragraph 3a does not apply, i.e. Home Produce Section, in sponsored classes and any age limit classes, in the event of there being no competition in any class, half the first prize money will be paid, three entries or no second prize money, five entries or no third prize

money in those classes where this is offered. The Committee has the right to delete or combine any class or competition in the event of there not being sufficient inducement of entry. 4. Exhibitors will be required to state as accurately as possible, at time of entry, the date of birth of exhibit in classes where the age is specified, also in sheep, the date of shearing. In horse classes, ages to be computed from 1st August. In all entries of livestock the breeder's name to be mentioned, if not known the fact must be stated at the time of entry. The pedigree of all stock must be given in the catalogue where possible. 5. No person shall have proprietorship for the time being in the pen which may have been allotted to the stock entered by such persons. No marks, brands or designs will be permitted in any entry in the produce classes, and no one will be permitted to put any placard or advertisement on the ground without the permission of the Committee. 6. Supervisors shall have the power to instruct not to demonstrate. 7. No stock shall be permitted to leave the grounds before 4 pm on the Saturday of the Show without the permission of the Committee. 8. Any cow or ewe which is barren shall not be eligible to take a prize except in the fat stock classes. Lambs must be shown with all ewes above 16 months, unless otherwise specified. 9. All exhibits of Implements and Machinery, Trade Exhibits, Sheep (except Fat Lambs, Pets and Flock Sheep), Cattle (except where otherwise stated), Farm Produce, Bacon, Home and Dairy Produce (except where otherwise specified) must be on the grounds by 8.30am on both days. NOTE a fine may be inflicted (not to exceed \$1.00) on any exhibit coming in late. Sheep which are not in pens by 9am will be disqualified from competition. 10. In Sheep Classes the pens will be numbered to correspond with the entry numbers of exhibits as stated in the catalogue. 11. The Committee will not under any circumstances hold themselves responsible for any damage or miss-delivery of stock or exhibits of any kind exhibited at the show. 12. Exhibitors and Attendants on ground at own risk and riders of horses and ponies compete at their own risk. 13a. All protests must be in writing and may be entered either before or after the Judges have proceeded to their duties. Any person entering a protest must deposit \$50 which will be refunded except if the protest held by the Committee to be frivolous. If any protest be lodged before the Judges proceed to their duties, the onus of disproof will rest with the exhibitor, if after that, that onus of proof will be with the person protesting. No protest will be received later than two hours after the prize tickets have been attached. The Committee is not less than five members thereof shall decide all protests as soon as possible, and there shall be no appeal from their decision. 13b. All persons admitted into the Showgrounds shall be subject to the rules and orders of the Committee. 14. Exhibitors infringing any of the above Regulations shall be subject to and dealt with as may be decided by the committee or sub-committee which shall be final. 15. The value of points shall be First Prize 5, Second Prize 3, Third Prize 2, Commended 1. Stewards are instructed to place second and third tickets on all exhibits in Special Classes. 16. No Champion ticket or ribbon will be awarded in any section where in the opinion of the Judge not sufficient merit is shown. 17. In the event of there being only one entry in a cup or trophy class, no award to be made if the Judge does not consider the exhibit of sufficient merit, otherwise the Cup or Trophy to be awarded. 18. GRAND PARADE: All prizewinners are requested to be present in the Grand Parade - failure to do so may result in the refunding of Prize Money, Sponsorship and Ribbons. No animal will be allowed to take part in the Grand Parade carrying an award or ribbon won at previous shows. 19. Judges are directed that stud animals having genital defects are to be disqualified. 20. Stock suspected of being affected with any infection foot complaint or lice shall be subject to an inspection by a stock inspector or a veterinary surgeon and should the stock be found to be infected it should be removed from the Showgrounds. 21. All Cattle to be Registered as Pure Breeds with their own Society to record all animal movements with NAIT 48 hours prior to leaving the farm/property for the Show and then within 48 hours of returning to the farm/property from the Show. Marlborough A & P Association NAIT No. 455008 23. PROTESTS: All protests must be in writing and lodged with the Secretary/Manager either before or after the Judges have proceeded to their duties. Any exhibitor lodging a protest must deposit \$50.00 which will be forfeited if the protest/s be not sustained. If the protest be lodged before the Judges proceed with their duties, the onus of proof will rest with the Exhibitor. No protest will be accepted later than 1 hour after the prize-tickets are affixed. The Committee will decide all protests as soon as practicable, and there shall be no appeal from their decision. 24. AGRICULTURAL AND PASTORAL SOCIETIES ACT 1908: Should any Exhibitor in the opinion of the

Committee, be guilty of any fraudulent or unfair practice, or any deceit or concealment, either in entering or exhibiting stock or any other exhibit, all exhibits of such an exhibitor shall be disqualified. Should an Exhibitor infringe any of these Rules and Regulations or refuse to comply with the direction of the Committee, the Committee shall have the power to suspend such a person as they may think fit. Should any person or firm be disqualified or suspended by a kindred Association, the Committee of the Association shall have the power to endorse such disqualification or suspension and disqualify and suspend such a person or firm accordingly. 25. YELLOW CARD - This Show/Event supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system. A Yellow Card will be issued, In cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website - [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz) . 26. FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCE - The Rules of the Royal A & P Society New Zealand in regard to Forbidden Substances apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems. 27. ARREARS - No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other show/event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated show/event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted. 28. Summary of RAS Resolution Process - the full process can be found on the RAS website [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz) . The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regards to an RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner. Any Exhibitor infringing any of the Regulations shall be subject to and be dealt with as may be decided upon by the Committee, or a Sub-Committee, whose decision shall be final.

## HORSE AND PONY - RULES AND REGULATIONS

MARLBOROUGH A & P ASSOCIATION HORSE SECTION RULES & REGULATIONS NOTE: These are to be read in conjunction with the rules and conditions outlined in their respective sections, and the Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ and their Affiliated Associations. 1. All entries must be made in writing to the Secretary, on or before the closing date published, and must be made in the name of the bona fide owner of the exhibit. Fees must be paid at the time of entry; no entry will be valid unless these conditions are complied with. 2. Refunds of up to 75% of entry fees may be paid at the discretion of the General Committee of the Marlborough A & P Association upon receipt of a veterinary or doctors certificate accompanying a written explanation as to the reason for the request - WITHIN SEVEN DAYS following the show (no refunds will be accepted after this time). 3. In horse classes age to be computed from the 1st August. 4. HORSE SECTION - JUDGING TO COMMENCE AT 8.00AM on both days. 5. The committee will not under any circumstance hold themselves responsible for loss, damage or misdelivery of any Stock, Implements or other exhibits of any description exhibited at the show. Entrants for any events, classes or competitions who exhibit, compete or participate therein, do so entirely at their own risk in every respect and neither the Association nor any officer, agent or employee thereof shall be in any way responsible for any loss, injury, damage or casualty whatsoever thereby resulting directly or indirectly either to the entrant or to his or her exhibits. 6. All persons entering the grounds must comply with the Health, Safety & Employment Act 1992 and subsequent amendments. 7. All persons admitted to the show shall be subject to the rules and orders of the committee, and admittance may be refused to any person who has not paid the correct fee or who does not hold a pass admitting him. 8. All protests must be in writing, and lodged, with the secretary either before or after the judges have proceeded to their duties. Any exhibiter entering a protest must deposit \$50 which will be forfeited if the protest were not sustained. If the protest is lodged before the judges proceed to their

duties, the onus of proof will rest with the exhibitor. If after that the onus of proof will be with the party protesting. No protest will be received later than half an hour after the prize tickets are affixed. The committee will decide all protests as soon as practicable, and there should be no appeal from their decision. 9. The value of points shall be First 5, Second 3, Third 2, and Fourth 1. 10. No horse or pony under 3 years of age may be shown in saddle classes. 11. A novice is a horse or pony which has yet to win 6 firsts in confirmation classes at any A & P shows, at the time of the show. Novice horses & ponies must be shown in snaffle bits only, in novice classes. Novice pony classes are open to riders of any age. If a novice entry has gained 6 firsts by the day of the show, the competitor must advise the Secretary's office and may change to an open class, or if no class remains to enter, a refund will be actioned at such a time as the Show Committee decides. 12. Open ponies must be ridden by riders under 17 years of age except that riders turning 17 years after 1st August are able to ride ponies for the rest of the current season. 13. Rider/Handler's age and eligibility is determined as per the 1 August i.e. Riders/Handlers who are of age for any division/section on the 1 August complete the show year/season in that division/section. 14. Stallions & Colts a) All stallions and colts (with the exception of Miniature horses and foals) must be shown in a bit. b) A Steward will order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor. c) It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider must also wear two (2) RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands from RAS Head Office. d) Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring. Vest can be purchased from RAS Head Office. 15. The Marlborough A & P Association reserve the right to use all photographs taken on behalf of the Marlborough A & P Association without permission. 16. YELLOW CARD - This Show/Event supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system.
