Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds. Riders in all Pony Classes and Competitions must be under 17 years of age, except where otherwise stated. Novice ponies may be ridden by an adult. A Novice is a pony that has not won a first prize (prior to this Show) at any Agricultural and Pastoral Show except in Local events.
